

### Daily Dose of Science Challenge: Sugar Glider Craft

## How to make an egg carton sugar glider craft

### You will need:

- An egg carton
- Scissors
- Acrylic paint
- Hot glue gun
- A scrap of paper
- Black marker
- Glue stick

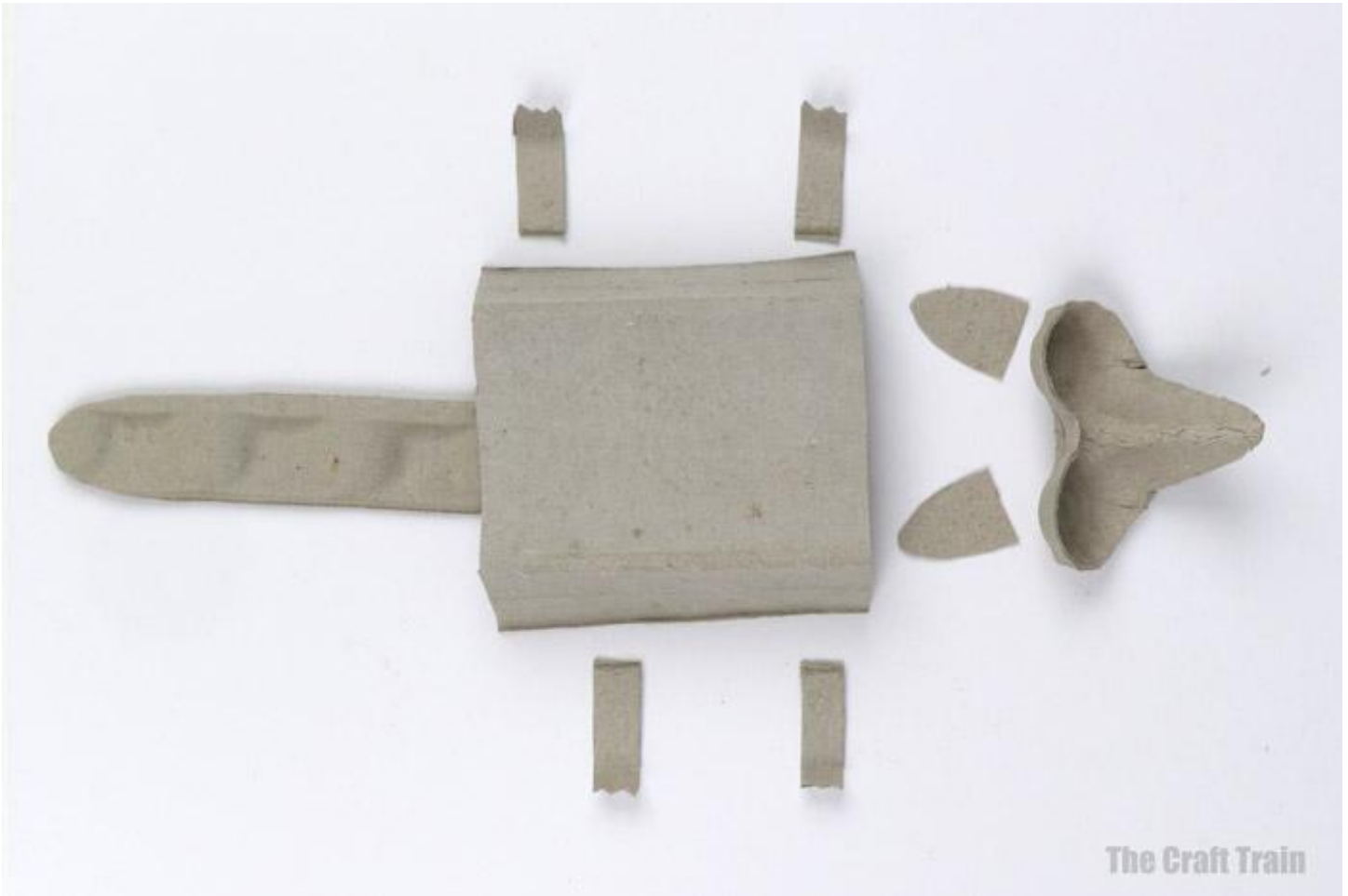
### How to:

Cut the egg carton up into pieces, the best way to explain how is with the video tutorial.

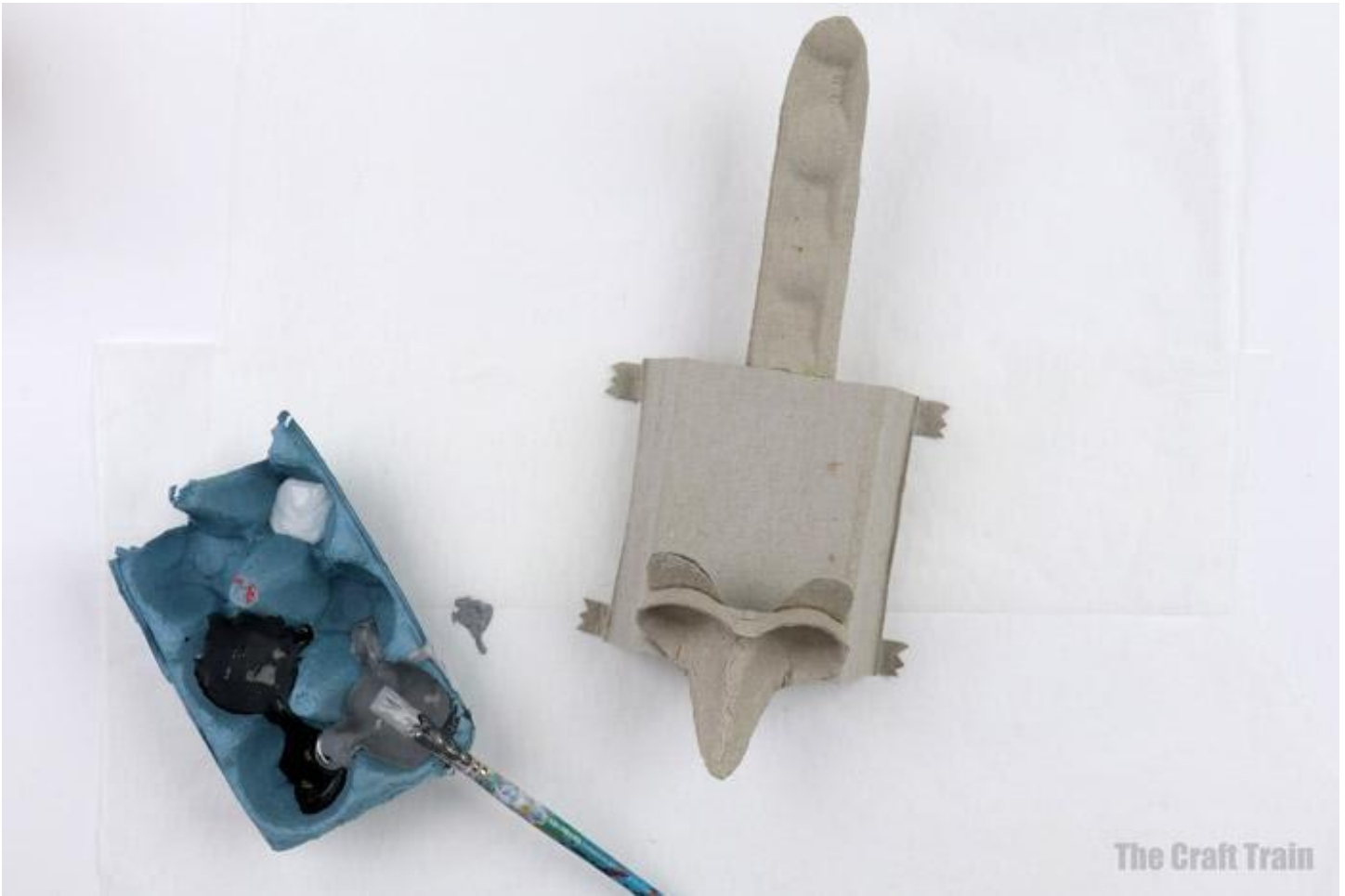
Here is a photograph of the finished pieces ready to be assembled. The feet are made of the sides of the flat piece including the bend, which have been cut into toes. The tail is the flap which closes the carton. The body is the middle section of the flat piece. The ears are made from a scrap of the flat piece. The head is made from two cups joined together with the pointy bit still attached, trimmed down to size.





Use a hot glue gun to stick the pieces together.





Paint it with acrylic paints. I've attempted to stick to a simplified version of the actual markings of the sugar glider.

A lot of kids would probably prefer to get creative and paint it however they like though, that is fine – there are no rules!





### The Craft Train

Draw two eyes which are roughly the size of the inner circle. You can just guesstimate it, the eyes I drew are maybe a millimetre or two wider than the inner circle when glued inside, which is fine. It doesn't need to be perfect. Use a glue stick to glue the eyes into place.





...and that's all there is to it! This little sugar glider is ready to play.
